eBay Checkout

eBay Checkout: Details




- Hosted by eBay
- Allows buyers to check out multiple items at once, applying shipping discounts when applicable
- No buyer-facing UI development needed
- No ability to build a customer relationship





eBay Checkout Flow





eBay Checkout: Gathering Payment Info



- Options
 - eBay Platform Notifications
 - Real-time notification of sale completion
 - Requires a server listener to handle notifications
 - Periodic call to GetSellerTransactions
 - Call to GetItemTransactions for specific item





PayPal Payment Review for eBay Items




- Every PayPal payment for eBay items can be potentially selected for further review
- If selected, it can take up to 24 hours for PayPal to "release" from review
- Introduced March '08
- Better support through IPNs later this year





PayPal Payment Review for eBay Items





7: If hold status equals "None" or "Released," check for Reversal IPN

If hold status equals "Payment Review," check status again within 24 hours

6: Call GetItemTransactions and check for PaymentReviewHoldStatus value

PayPal Website Payments Standard



PayPal Cart

- "HTML form"-based and cart is hosted by PayPal
- Limited functionality and control over UI
- No control over when the payment is actually placed on PayPal
- Easy to implement





PayPal Website Payments Standard



PayPal Cart Upload

- Cart is hosted on your site, but it's "uploaded" to PayPal when buyer is ready to check out
- Allow payment for eBay items
- No control over when the payment is actually placed on PayPal
- Prone to address mismatch problems
- Good solution for small merchants





PayPal Website Payments Pro: Express Checkout Overview




- Payment is completed on your site
- Increased conversion rate
 - Quicker and easier way to use checkout process
 - Higher buyer confidence regarding business legitimacy
- No need to gather buyers' billing/payment info
- No more mismatched shipping addresses (eBay)





PayPal Website Payments Pro: Express Checkout







PayPal Website Payments Pro: Express Checkout API Overview



Simple

 Calls are simple to understand (from a conceptual level) and easy to implement

Flexible

 Allows multiple levels of details. If you just want to pass on the total payment amount, you can. If you want to send item-by-item details, you can also do that.

Open Control

Allows your checkout flow to do whatever you want





PayPal Website Payments Standard & Pro: Pay Later




- Allows you to offer promotional financing on your Web site, so your buyer can shop now and pay later
- Increases conversion and average selling price through "impulse" buying
- Available through Payments Standard and Pro (Express Checkout)





PayPal Website Payments Standard & Pro: Pay Later









PayPal Website Payments Standard & Pro: Pay Later



- PayPal has some marketing requirements
 - Banner on home page, product details, checkout buttons
- Express Checkout Implementation
 - Set the PromoCode variable with value "101" for the SetExpressCheckout call (SDK v3.3)
- Contact your PayPal rep to check for eligibility






PayPal Website Payments Pro: Direct Payments



Payment is completed on your site Different than Express Checkout, the buyer never leaves your site







PayPal Website Payments Pro: Direct Payments Overview



- Requires the gathering of buyers' billing/payment info (credit card info) and the liability of handling/storing it
- Requires Express Checkout as part of PayPal's SLA





PayPal Website Payments Pro: Auth/Capture Overview



- Allow merchant to authorize payment for later capture
 - Ideal for upselling other items or upgrading shipping
- Available to both Express Checkout and Direct Payments
- Requires implementing an extra 2 API calls:
 DoAuthorization, DoCapture





PayPal Website Payments Pro: Reference Transactions



- Allows you to charge/re-charge a credit card using only the auth code (PayPal Reference ID) from a previous authorization/charge
- Avoids having to store sensitive user information in your environment
- Implemented by the DoReferenceTransaction call






PayPal Instant Payment Notifications (IPN)



- Real-time name/value pair-based notification
- Needed for handling post-sale confirmation notifications of Pending Payments (i.e., "Address," "Echeck")
- Requires a listener Web application



PayPal Instant Payment Notifications (IPN)



Order Status Change Flow:

Checkout Completed with Pending Payment (Echeck)

PayPal Recurring Payments




- Now available through Payments Pro
 - Express Checkout and Direct Payments
- Ideal for subscriptions for services or memberships
- Requires the implementation of CreateRecurringPaymentsProfile
