

- All SDKs
 - Support 569
 - Make it easier to use Auth & Auth
- SDK for Windows
 - Adding .NET Framework 2.0 Support
 - Deprecating .NET Framework 1.0 Support



SDK for Java



- Migrating to JAXB data binding per the JAX-WS standard
 - Performance and stability improvements
 - Standardized solution: No more custom Axis
 - Parsing improvement
 - Flexibility at transport level
- JDK Upgrades
 - Supported: JDK 1.5, JDK 1.6
 - Not supported: JDK 1.4 and Axis 1.1
 - JDK 1.4 and Axis 1.1 will be supported for the next year, but there will be no new SDK releases for that environment



Large Seller Improvements

Large Seller Improvements



- Better API and business process support for high volume sellers
- Faster processing and fewer timeouts with asynchronous bulk interface
- Manage entire business without going to My eBay
- Ability to organize information by SKU instead of ItemID
- Available in September (we hope)



Large Seller Improvements



- Batch changes
 - Item additions, ending, price updates
- Variants: Base item with differences
 - e.g., Size, Color, Memory, Material
 - Compress multiple listings into one listing
- Feedback automation
 - Rules to automatically provide positive feedback
- ASQ: Redirection to CS email
- Invoices: Invoices to A/P email



Product Changes

Making eBay Better



- Create a first-class buyer experience
- Create a trusted marketplace
- We're investing a lot to make that happen
- But we can't do it alone
- We need sellers to provide a first class experience to our mutual customers
- One rotten seller will ruin a top buyer
- We need developers to help sellers be successful
- · Talk to us. Share your thoughts. We will listen.



Improving the Buyer Experience



- Number of recent policy changes to improve the overall buyer experience
- Mandating "critical item information"
- Previously optional elements

 Minimal API changes
- If you haven't already implemented these features, you have until July...some later
- More changes may be coming



Shipping



- All items must specify at least one domestic shipping service
- Strongly suggest you pass weight and dimensions for our "shipping calculator"
 - Lower shipping prices → Higher in search results
- Freight is being added as a service
- Ability to provide tracking information
 - Improve Shipping time, Communication DSRs
 - Release funds earlier



Shipping



- Includes items using third-party checkout
- No longer accepting additional third-party checkout applications

Handling Time



- All sellers must include a handling time in the listing
- That time will be used to provide an estimated arrival time to the buyer
- Will make it clear that handling time starts when the buyer's payment has cleared, not at the time of purchase



Return Policy



- All sellers must specify a return policy
- Policy must specify who pays for return
- This policy can be "none"
- Not applicable in certain categories/formats
- Return policy in the schema is being moved from an attribute to a higher level node.
 Both values will be accepted until Feb. 2009.



Payments



- Provide buyers with a consistent, safe checkout experience every time they shop
 - Increase buyer confidence
 - Decrease online fraud
- Safer payment methods for buyers
 - Reduce unpaid items, Items Not Received, and Negative Feedback

Payments



- Australia: PayPal only as of mid July
- United Kingdom: PayPal required as of 6/3
- United States: Will not be going to PayPal only
- Other countries: TBD
- Exceptions made for certain categories, dependent on country, such as Vehicles or Capital Equipment



Making eBay Safer



- Number of recent and upcoming changes to improve safety on eBay
- Want buyers to feel completely confident when they're shopping on eBay
- Higher trust → higher willingness to pay → increased turns and higher prices



Anonymous Member Email Addresses



- "Anonymize" email addresses sent through the member-to-member communication system including Ask Seller a Question and Reply to Question
- Industry-standard best practice to protect member privacy and help prevent fraud
- Sandbox available in July



Anonymous Member Email Addresses



- Sellers can still reply to "anonymized" email addresses
- Sellers will receive the buyers actual email address upon completion of the transaction
- Seller email addresses can no longer be included in listings



Item Templates & Description



- Improve the safety of View Item pages
- Only site that allows full HTML and CSS
- Moving from blacklist to whitelist approach
- Will impact JavaScript and Flash widgets
- Also moving Description to separate domain

Links Policy



- Generally speaking, no links off eBay, whether or not an item is being offered for sale on that site
- Exceptions
 - Link to photos of the item for sale, as long as the page displaying the photos does not offer, or link to, a site that offers a product or service for sale off-eBay



Links Policy



- Links or credits to third party solutions and services directly, related to the particular listing, as long as the credit
 - Contains no more than 10 words of text (HTML font size 3); if the credit is a logo, it may be no larger than 88x33 pixels in size, including backgrounds and borders, and it may not flash or otherwise move
 - Contains no promotional material about additional services or other information about the company
 - Links only to the third party company's Web page containing information about the specific eBay service provided in the listing

Links Policy



- Not a comprehensive list
- More specifics to come



Verification of New Sellers



- New sellers now verified with
 - A call to their registered phone number
 - PayPal verified or Live Chat verified
- After their first few listings or high dollar amount



Trusted Selling With Identity Confirmation



- Members using unrecognized computers may need to enter PIN received over the phone when signing in to eBay
- No identity checks when using API, but possible when getting token via Auth & Auth
- A phone call from eBay to their registered phone number with a PIN. That PIN should be entered in the next screen.
- Be prepared for these identity checks when signing up new customers or when user token has expired
- Prepare your customers for what they will experience, and to make sure they have a current phone number on file with eBay
