

1 GATHER YOUR PAPERWORK*:

We recommend finding your vehicle registration insurance card or your title/pink slip, since they contain important information (example: make, model, year, VIN) that you will need to complete your eBay vehicle listing.

2 VEHICLE INFORMATION:

Tip: You can find your VIN in one or more of the following places:

Photo Check List:

They say that a picture is worth a thousand words, so be sure to make your vehicle looks its best.

Tip: Ideally it is best to take the photos of your vehicle in a well-lit location or on a sunny day

*Please note that each state has different requirements for the paperwork required to sell a vehicle. You may want to contact your local Department of Motor Vehicles to make sure you have all the necessary paperwork.

3 ADDITIONAL HELPFUL INFORMATION TO CREATE A GREAT VEHICLE LISTING

Fill out the "Describe your vehicle" Section:

1. Additional equipment and accessories: Are there any additional accessories or equipment on your vehicle that you want to share? Have you done any upgrades to the vehicle that might interest a buyer?

Example: Anti-theft system, heated seats, towing package, satellite radio, built-in navigation/GPS system, iPod/MP3 jack, upgraded wheels/rims, rear seat entertainment center

2. Maintenance history: By offering buyers maintenance records on your vehicle, it increases their confidence to bid or purchase your vehicle. It is also a good idea to let potential buyers know about recent maintenance or repairs performed, such as new tires or a new timing belt.

Example: Completed 60K tune-up 6 months ago, new tires, all maintenance records available

3. Warranty details: If this vehicle is still covered by factory or extended warranty, share what type of coverage is provided and if it is transferrable

4. Condition of the vehicle, including notable damage, wear or problems: Are there obvious issues with the vehicle that cannot be shown in the photos?

Example: Small scratches on bumper, tear in left passenger seat, 90K mile tune-up due, cigarette burn on driver's seat

Know what price you want for your vehicle

We recommend researching the value of your vehicle:

- Search eBay Motors for similar vehicles and review their sales history
- Consider using a vehicle value research service, such as [Kelley Blue Book](#)
