Resources for Law Enforcement Investigations and Service Levels

eBay Inc developed two systems to enable law enforcement officers seeking records for investigations related to the eBay platform quickly and securely:

LEP (Law Enforcement Portal) is a tool that allows registered Law Enforcement officers to obtain eBay user information without the need of faxing a data request. An eBay userID, email address or item number is required to obtain users' data. The officer can download the information directly from the portal. It's fast, easy and safe to use. Requests will be retrievable in 3-5 working days.

UK Police and Trading Standard forces can submit users' data requests through a nation-wide network of **SPOCs** and **RIOs**. If unsure who the SPOC for your area is, you can contact us at **uklep@ebay.com**.

Please note all LEP registered users and SPOCs should continue to utilize the Portal for all eBay data requests.

➤ **LERS** (Law Enforcement eRequest System) is a online webform designed for judges, public prosecutors and government agencies to submit their eBay data requests, inclusive of uploading their supporting documents such as a court order. This site (https://lers.corp.ebay.com) may only be used by law enforcement personnel who will go through an authentication processes.

This has replaced the previous process of faxing or emailing data to us. Requests submitted via LERS are still handled manually by our team and are processed in approximately **20 working days**.

Requirements for eBay data requests

Requests submitted through LERS and via manual process must comply with the following legal requirements:

- ➤ Must be Addressed to eBay Europe S.à r.l, which is the entity name of the data controller of the European eBay sites.
- ➤ Must be a Typed official document bearing the logo of the requestor
- ➤ Must be Signed by the law enforcement officer in charge of the investigation
- Must quote the applicable act or law under which the LE agency is requesting the data under.

Also, all requests should include:

- > Officer's name, department, street address, telephone, fax and email address.
- > All known email addresses, names and aliases of the subject
- > Exactly what information is required, how it pertains to eBay and your investigation

Important Note:

All requests that are not addressed to the correct eBay entity (eBay Europe S.à r.l), will be rejected.

Priority will be given only in particular circumstances and investigation types (ie. life threatening issues etc.) and only where the sense of urgency is appropriately specified
