Each piece of wearable art features a print that brings together designs and symbols from the artist's heritage. Incorporating modern aesthetics and colour trends, these scarves are fit for fall 2016!

All scarves are made in Canada, with 100 per cent of sale proceeds going to each artist's charity of choice.



JORDAN BENNETT x eBay

Illustrated by hand, Bennett's designs take inspiration from the land his people live and depend on and emphasize the importance of the identities and traditions of the Mi'kmaq people. His work has been shown in art galleries nationally and internationally, and this Collaboration is the first time his designs have been used in fashion pieces.



JORDAN BENNETT x eBay SEASONS THROUGH BLACK AND WHITE

This design is inspired by the complex geometric patterns found in Mi'kmaq porcupine quillwork. There are several elements in this piece that speak to the changing of the seasons, inspiration from the land, and movement across time and place. This embedded story, along with other visual elements for the Mi'kmaq culture, make up the overall design.

JORDAN BENNETT x eBay
RED PORCUPINE QUILL MOUNTAIN
(MEKWE'K KAWI KMTN)

Composed of various elements found in Mi'kmaq quill and spruce root design, this piece focuses on the stepped motif – a representation of a mountain. The stacked lines are based on quillwork to represent the soil horizons, while the arch over the mountain represents the sky, or, depending on orientation, the water.

With the design centered around the tree of life, the surrounding leaves represent humankind, emphasizing the cycle of life and the changes that occur season to season.
